



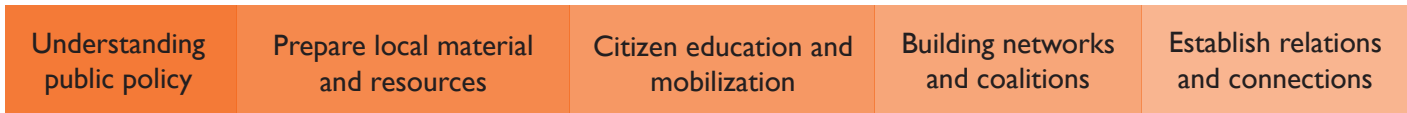

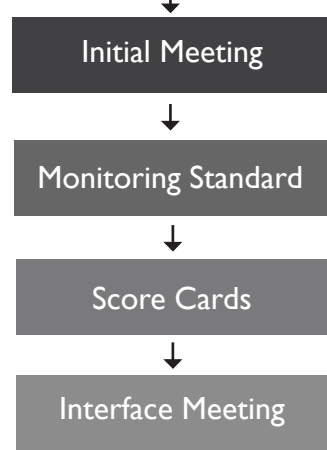

3 Stages of Citizen Voice and Action

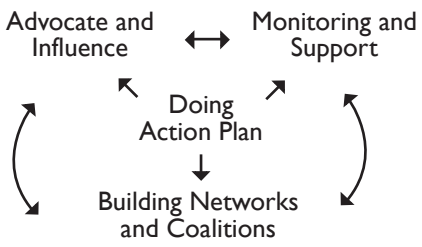
1. Enabling Citizen Engagement

Who are Empowered by This Action

3 CSO coalitions, who have been empowered by capacity building activities to analyze government policy and budget to be able to recommend new policy and alternative budget. After the project ends, these three CSO Coalitions will be independently working to improvement of child-well being. All 3 CSO Coalitions are legally registered in local government and Ministry of Law and Human Rights.

3 Child forums, 1 in each district, have been empowered with set of skill, such as journalism, photo/videography, digital campaign, mini research for making recommendation and other training, to be able to do advocacy in a way that is interesting to them.

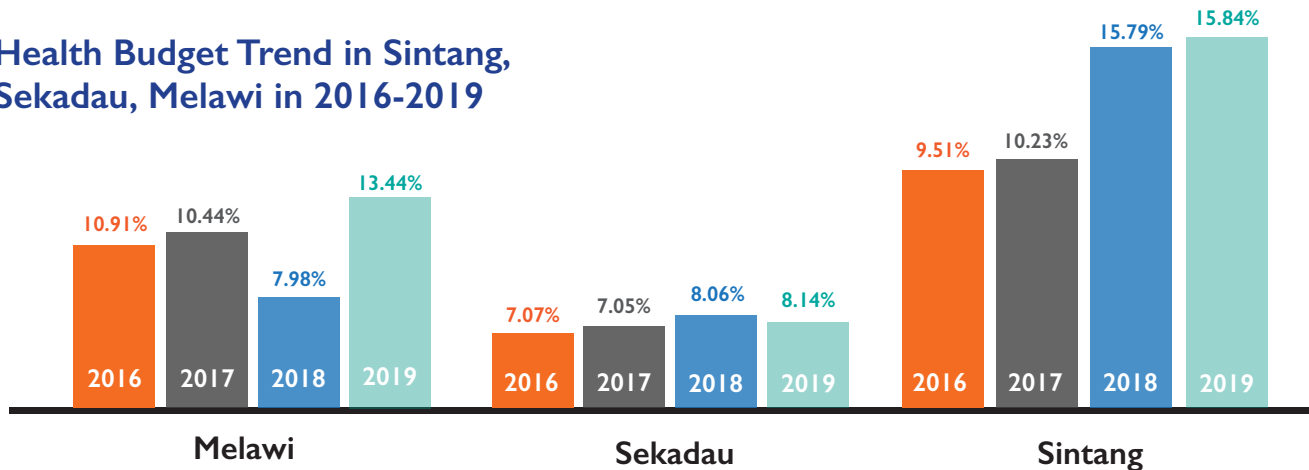

Mobile Community Health Center Citizen's Voice and Action

Construction of the Kebong Community Health Center (Puskesmas) in Sintang and the provision of a Mobile Community Health Center are the impact of Citizen's Voice and Action. Previously, the health center is located in a less secure area, almost close to a cliff.

Sintang's CSO Coalitions recommended improvement based on Health Center Service's service standards which resulted in government allocated for construction of new Puskesmas and also mobile health centers that serves and benefits Sintang community.
